Two cows will be recognized for outstanding production on June 30, 2007, during the 139th Annual Meeting of the American Jersey Cattle Association, in Sioux Falls, S.D.

With her most recent lifetime milk production totals (301,147 lbs. milk), Duncan Hibrite of Family Hill, owned by Ryan A. Lancaster, Ferndale, Wash., becomes one of two cows in breed history to produce more than 300,000 lbs. milk. The other is Maplerow Mercury Aron-PTL-P with 310,330 lbs. milk in 1999.

"Hibrite" will receive the Ogston Trophy for milk production, the High Lawn Trophy for fat production and the Edyvean Farm Trophy for protein production.

Also being recognized in Sioux Falls will be Sweet Peas Imperial Kassie, winner of both the President's Trophy and the Hilmar Cheese Yield Trophy. "Kassie" is owned by Heather Pease, Susquehanna, Pa.

The Leading Living Lifetime Production Contest distinguishes cows alive as of December 31 of the contest year that have produced a minimum of 200,000 lbs. milk, 9,500 lbs. fat or 7,500 lbs. protein. Only DHIR production credits are used to calculate the standings.

This year, 18 cows were nominated for the contest. The top 10 for milk production all produced over 223,000 lbs. milk, averaged 3,858 days in milk and had an average daily production of 63 lbs. milk. For fat production, the top 10 all documented records over 10,700 lbs. fat and had an average daily production of 3.2 lbs. fat. The top 10 for protein production had an average daily production of 2.3 lbs. protein and records in excess of 8,300 lbs. protein.

As a group, the top 15 individuals in each category averaged 235,412 lbs. milk, 11,437 lbs. fat and 8,572 lbs. protein. The group had daily production averages of 63 lbs. milk, 3.1 lbs. fat and 2.3 lbs. protein.

For the second consecutive year, "Hibrite" earns the top spot for lifetime milk production, beating her closest competitor by more than 30,000 lbs. milk. For the first time, she moves to the top spot for fat and protein production as well, having moved up from fourth place for fat and second for protein in last year's contest.

In 4,846 days, the Excellent-93% daughter of Highland Magic Duncan, JPI -47, produced 301,147 lbs. milk, 13,973 lbs. fat and 10,526 lbs. protein. Her average

daily production to date is 62 lbs. milk, 2.9 lbs. fat and 2.2 lbs. protein. To date, the 17-year-old has produced 11 lactations, seven of them exceeding 20,000 lbs. milk. Her best 305-day record was made at 9-8, when she produced 23,620 lbs. milk, 1,101 lbs. fat and 852 lbs. protein. "Hibrite" was bred by Kelle J. Weisberg, Kent, Wash.

Ranking second in the milk production category is Marty Lue of Golden Meadows, owned by the Paul Dias Family, Hilmar, Calif. The Excellent-90% daughter of Rock Maple Sooner Marty-ET, JPI +30, made 270,791 lbs. milk, 12,828 lbs. fat and 9,690 lbs. protein in 3,524 days. The daily average on this production is 77 lbs. milk, 3.6 lbs. fat and 2.7 lbs. protein.

With these credits, "Marty Lue" placed second in protein and third in fat in this year's Leading Living Lifetime Production Contest. She has produced nine completed lactations to date, eight of them over 23,000 lbs. milk. "Marty Lue" made a top 305-day record of 31,040 lbs. milk, 1,533 lbs. fat and 1,090 lbs. protein at 6-2. This is the second time she has placed in the contest, having placed fifth for milk and sixth for fat and protein production last year. "Marty Lue" was bred by Knight and Ruth N. Abbott, Cabot, Vt.

The third high cow for lifetime milk production is a herdmate to "Hibrite" at Family Hill Jerseys in western Washington—Maurice Trader Chancel. She also breaks into the component categories of the production contest this year, ranked fifth for protein and sixth for fat production. The Excellent-94% daughter of Avon Road Trader, JPI -33, is owned by Aaron and Ryan Lancaster of Ferndale and was bred by Ron and Dean Maurice, Conover, Ohio. In 4,118 days, she made 239,560 lbs. milk, 11,700 lbs. fat and 8,857 lbs. protein. Her daily production averages are 58 lbs. milk, 2.8 lbs. fat and 2.2 lbs. protein.

The second-ranked cow for lifetime fat production is Homewood Daffys Laughter, owned by Brian Bohnert, East Moline, Ill. For four years, the Excellent-90% "Laughter" has graced the list of leading lifetime producers. Her lifetime credits of 237,816 lbs. milk, 13,398 lbs. fat and 8,890 lbs. protein in 3,800 days rank her fourth for protein and fifth for milk production in this year's contest. Her daily production average is 63 lbs. milk, 3.5 lbs. fat and 2.3 lbs. protein. Over her 10 lactations, the 15-year-old daughter of Boomer Sooner Beths Lad-ET, JPI -26, had component averages of 5.1% for fat and 3.7% for protein and produced 19,866 lbs. milk actual.

"Laughter" was bred by fellow Illinois Jersey breeders, Trimble Farms, Robinson.

The Winners of the President's Trophy

The President's Trophy is an annual award recognizing the high-record cow on official AJCA testing programs of the previous year. Since 1990, it has been awarded to the cow completing the top record for m.e. pounds protein. Previously, it was awarded on the basis of standardized 3.5% fat, 3.2% protein yield (1987-1989); 4% fat-corrected milk (FCM) (1983-1986); dollar value (1975-1982); m.e. milk record (1964-1974); high m.e. fat record (1961-1963); and prior to 1961, to the high actual fat record.

Rounding out the top three for protein production is milk wagon, Huestis Brook Gail, owned by junior Jersey breeder, Cassandra L. Chittenden, Schodack Landing, N.Y. She made 233,233 lbs. milk, 12,435 lbs. fat and 9,084 lbs. protein in 3,978 days. "Gail" also ranked eighth for milk and fourth for fat production with these marks. Her daily production average is 59 lbs. milk, 3.1 lbs. fat and 2.3 lbs. protein. She is appraised Excellent-91% and is sired by Molly Brook Brass Major, JPI +22. "Gail" was bred by Ron and Lisa M. Huestis, Cottage Grove, Tenn.

President's and Hilmar Cheese Yield Trophies

The President's Trophy is awarded annually to the Jersey cow with the highest mature equivalent (m.e.) protein record during the test year. The Hilmar Cheese Yield Trophy is presented to the cow with the highest yield of 38% moisture Cheddar cheese, calculated from actual production of no more than 305 days and completed during the contest year.

Receiving both production awards will be Sweet Peas Imperial Kassie, Excellent-90%. In her second lactation at 3-6, she produced a 305-day record of 34,120 lbs. milk, 1,762 lbs. fat and 1,395 lbs. protein, with an m.e. of 41,043 lbs. milk, 2,091 lbs. fat and 1,643 lbs. protein. The record equates to 4,761 lbs. cheese yield and makes her the reigning National Class Leader for cheese yield and protein among junior three-year-olds as well. She is sired by Meadow Lawn J Imperial 50R-ET, JPI -24.

Other individuals with cheese yield over 4,100 lbs. were: Saybrook Whistling Mischiff, owned by John Tighe and Russell Subject, Oldwick, N.J., with her 4-1 record of 4,385 lbs. cheese yield; Ladyholm-N Jewels Jade, owned by Heather Pease, with a 5-9 record of 4,274 lbs. cheese yield; Queen-Acres Lucky Perimiter and Queen-Acres Millenium Libby-ET, owned by James L. and Sharon L. Osborn, Keymar, Md., with respective cheese yield records of 4,263 lbs. cheese yield at 3-8 and 4,184 cheese yield at 3-4; BW Parade Corine D27, owned by Brentwood Farms, Orland, Calif., with a 4-2 record of 4,154 lbs. cheese yield; and Select Lily of Mainstream, owned by Melissa R. Kortus, Lynden, Wash., with a 7-8 record of 4,116 lbs. cheese yield.
