

Correction for 2005 Sales Averages

The sale price of Ratliff Prospect Candy, who sold in the 2005 Oklahoma State Sale, was incorrectly reported on page 33 of the February issue of the *Jersey Journal*. The first-trimester bred heifer sold for \$2,600 rather than \$26,000. With the correction, the sale average for the Oklahoma State Sale now stands at \$2,791.67 on 18 lots. The sale grossed \$50,250 and remains the highest-averaging state sale for the year 2005.

The correction also impacts the year-end sales report, which begins on page 18 of the February *Jersey Journal*. Revised charts for the sale summary, top 10 sales and top three high-selling bred heifers are shown below.

Added to the chart of the Top 15 High Selling Animals at Public Auction in 2005, printed on page 20, should be 15th-ranked SHF Parade Goodgirl, who sold for \$12,400 in the Field of Dreams II Sale on June 4, 2005. Paul Kilgus, Fairbury, Ill., took home the two-year-old consignment of Norman E. Nabholz, West Union, Iowa.

“Goodgirl” is a granddaughter of the World Fat Champion, Golden MBSB of Twin Haven-ET.

Now topping the list of the Top Three High Selling Bred Heifers is another granddaughter of the record fat producer, MVF

Paramount Gold 1218-ET. “Gold 1218” sold for \$14,100 in the all-donation National Heifer Sale on June 25, 2005. She was consigned by Meadow View Farm, Pine Grove, Pa., and purchased by the Golden River Syndicate, Seymour, Wis.

Now ranking third among bred heifers is Elliotts Deluxe Vanessa-ET, who sold for \$12,000 in the Super Bowl of Genetics Sale on January 29, 2005. She was consigned by Robert and Kathy Yeoman, Dover, Okla., and purchased by Andrew E. Dice, Fredricksburg, Pa. She is a daughter of Huronia Centurion Veronica 20J, Grand Champion of the 2005 Central National Jersey Show.
