We purchased "Jade" in August of 1995 from Frederick Havill, MA, and she has proved to be a valuable investment. She gave us 35 daughters and 25 sons.

Seven of her sons were sold to A.I. and produced a total of 3,385 registered daughters. Over 50 bulls in total have gone to A.I. from this family including 29JE3346 JEVON, who had 7,602 proof daughters in his December 2014 genetic evaluations.

Today, 897 female descendants have been registered from this family. The first tenth generation animal was born September 2014. Forty-eight female descendants have been appraised Excellent and 334 Very Good. This maternal line has been profitable in the milk tank and genetically. One hundred and ten descendants have completed lactations in excess of 20,000 lbs. milk actual. Currently, 12 cows and five heifers rank among their corresponding top 1.5% GJPI lists.
